

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

The Shower Valve has an optimal operating range of 20-80 psi


Periodic cleaning using a mild soap and warm water will help keep your product's appearance in its original condition.

To help restore the finish, occasionally apply a non-abrasive wax to your product (follow manufacturers' instructions).


INSTALL SPLINE ADAPTER

- 1 Remove the Protective Cover from Valve. Ensure the Valve is in the "OFF" position. Slide Splined Hex Shaft over the Valve Spindle, followed by Flat Washer, Lock Washer, and secure with Screw.






INSTALL WALL PLATE

- 2 Orient Wall Plate with the "OFF" marking at the top position as shown below. Place Wall Plate over the Hex Spline Adapter. Secure Wall Plate to the Shower Valve with the Screws provided.




INSTALL HANDLE ASSEMBLY

- 3 Verify Friction Ring is properly seated into the Friction Ring Groove of the Wall Plate (A). Orient the Handle Assembly, as shown below, with the arrow facing upwards. Install the Handle Assembly over the Wall Plate Splined Shaft. Secure with the Security Screw using the supplied Key Wrench. Verify smooth rotation of the Handle Assembly.



INSTALL SCREW COVER

- 4 Insert Screw Cover with O-Ring installed, into recess of Handle.



MAINTENANCE NOTE

To remove the Screw Cover for maintenance, insert a Paper Clip or similar item into the .04" access hole within the Handle Assembly as shown.



SITE PREPARATION


- 1 Ensure mounting location and structure are capable of supporting the product in use. When mounting the Shower Head, it is recommended that the screws be fastened into wood blocking or other substantial substrate.



INSTALL PIPE NIPPLE


- 2 Determine the length of the Ø 1/2" Pipe needed by following the diagram below. When properly installed the Ø 1/2" Pipe should extend from the finished wall per the dimensions. Ø 1/2" Pipe Nipple is not included.

Apply Thread Seal Tape to the end of the Pipe Nipple entering the wall. Wrench tighten Pipe Nipple into place.




TEST INSTALLATION

- 3 Thread Shower Head onto the Pipe Nipple using a Strap Wrench or Soft Jawed Pliers. Align mounting holes into the final desired position.




MARK MOUNTING LOCATIONS

- 4 Use a Pencil to mark the mounting hole locations. If installing the optional Anchor Plate (AP), trace the outline of the Shower Head onto the wall. After marking the mounting hole locations, remove the Shower Head.




MARK MOUNTING LOCATIONS (ANCHOR PLATE OPTION)

- 5 If installing the optional Anchor Plate (AP), align the Anchor Plate to the traced outline and mark the inner mounting holes onto the wall.




DRILL MOUNTING HOLES

- 6 Select a Drill Bit that is the appropriate type and size for the mounting hardware being used. If installing the S-2460, use the outer marked holes. If installing the optional Anchor Plate (AP) S-2460-AP use the inner set of marked holes. (*Vandal Resistant Mounting Hardware is not included and should be selected based upon the location materials.*)




INSTALL ANCHOR PLATE (ANCHOR PLATE OPTION)

- 7 If installing the optional Anchor Plate, secure to the wall with Mounting Hardware. (*Flat Head Mounting Hardware with a countersunk head is recommended, but not included*)



REINSTALL SHOWER HEAD

- 8 Apply Thread Seal Tape to remaining end of Pipe Nipple. Reinstall Shower Head using a Strap Wrench or Soft Jawed Pliers. Align Mounting Holes in Shower Head to the previously drilled mounting holes.




SECURE INTO FINAL POSITION


S-2460

Secure Shower Head into position using Vandal Resistant Mounting Screws. (*Vandal Resistant Mounting Hardware is not included and should be selected based upon the location materials.*)




S-2460-AP

Secure Shower Head onto the previously mounted Anchor Plate using the included Vandal Resistant Mounting Hardware and a 5/32" or 4mm Hex Key Wrench



SPRAY ADJUSTMENT

- 10 Loosen side Set Screw using a 3/32" (2.4mm) Hex Key Wrench (A), Adjust the spray pattern using a 3/16" (4.8mm) Hex Key Wrench (B). Tighten side Set Screw to secure desired spray pattern (A).



ROUGH IN DIAGRAM
